Check-in and Registration: Gates open Wednesday, 7/15 at 2:00 pm and Thursday, 7/16 at 9:00 am. Upon arrival and check-in, you will receive a Swag Bag with your name badge and information regarding camping, horse management, trail ride options, activities and meals.

Thursday's Pie Social and Saturday's breakfast and evening dinner will be provided by SBCH.

Your name badge is your meal ticket. Be sure to wear it to meals and bring your own chair to all meals and events!

Parking is Limited: You will be directed to your designated Chapter space upon check-in.

Livestock Management:

- No Stallions allowed.
- **Wyoming residents** bringing horses need Brand Inspections.
- **Out of state guests need** Brand Inspections, Health Certificates, and current Coggins tests for their horses.
- All horses should be healthy and current with vaccinations.
- **Certified Weed Free Hay is required** for the event and for all camping within SNF and YNP. Grazing is not available, nor allowed.
- **Horses and mules must be contained**, no loose horses will be permitted, even with hobbles.
- **Adjoining 12' x12' pens will be available to rent in advance** (see Registration form).
- *Due to possible wind events*, picketing, electric fence enclosures and highlines between trailers will be NOT be allowed.
- Personal horse containment using portable corrals is allowed outside of designated parking areas.
- **Manure:** Horse owners are expected to remove all manure from enclosures and disperse daily. Wheelbarrows will be provided for manure removal. *Please bring your own forks and shovels.*
- **Water:** Water will be available for horses; bring your own buckets.
No potable water is available on site. *Bring your own drinking water!*

Porta Potties will be available.

Trash: A Bear Resistant Dumpster will be available.

Dogs in camp must be leashed or contained and are not allowed in the area where we are serving food. Dogs are not allowed on organized rides.

Meals, Games, Activities and the Silent Auction will be held near the big Shop area, unless posted otherwise. Please wear your name badge and bring your own chair to meals and activities.

Group Meals: Thursday evening Pie Social is provided by Shoshone Back Country Horsemen; Friday is a Group Potluck Dinner, bring a dish to enjoy together; **Saturday** Breakfast and Dinner will be provided by SBCH; Guests are on their own for all other meals.
